

HOW TO PLAY 21 DASH



The Dice

Each die has six sides, ranked low to high: Nine, Ten, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace



The Goal

Accumulate **21 points** without going over (**Bust**) in fewer turns than your opponent.

Gameplay (2 Players)

Choose a player to begin.

When your turn starts, roll **all five dice**. After rolling, you can choose to re-roll once or twice more, with any or all dice.

Next, tally the highest available score or score **0 points** if there is no match.

* If during any turn you roll **Blackjack (three Aces and two Nines)**, you score exactly **21 points**, and claim victory.

* If your score ever totals above **21 points**, you **Bust** and start over from **0 points**.

Now it's the next player's turn.

Victory!

When a player accumulates exactly **21 points** or rolls **Blackjack**, they claim victory. However, both players must roll an equal amount of turns. Their opponent may have a chance to share the victory.

... Best out of three?
