TRIPLE SHOWDOWN



The Dice

Each die has six sides, ranked low to high: Nine, Ten, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace









The Goal

Roll to create Poker Hands and Triplets.

Gameplay (2 Players)

Choose a player to begin.

When your turn starts, roll all five dice. After rolling, you can choose to re-roll once or twice more, with any or all dice.

Next, choose a row to score your turn. Then, write an "X" in your opponent's column for the same row you scored.

The next player to score in that row gets double points. The player who scores in that row for the third time gets triple points.

* If after your turn, your roll doesn't meet the requirements of an available row, your turn ends without scoring any points.

Now it's the next player's turn.

Continue until all spaces are scored.

Victory!

The player with the most points wins! ... Best out of three?
